## 2023 - The 40th National HuiChun Calligraphy Gathering

- We are the pioneer of the local HuiChun. We have a history of 40 years since 1983. This is 4 years earlier than the "Spring at the Riverside".
- This convention is scheduled on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023(Sunday), from (9.00a.m. to 10.30a.m.) in the front courtyard and main hall of Singapore Calligraphy Centre (48 Waterloo Street Singapore 187952 Tel: 6337 7753) to welcome the year of "Jade Hare". This venue will be open to public to HuiChun Calligraphy until 3.00p.m.
- Admission is free for all to visit the "Jade Hare's Spring Couplets" exhibition which is concurrently open on the same day until January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023 (Wednesday)
- For the HuiChun:
  - it is every 15 mins per session with a total of 40 tables for writing.
  - we are anticipating around 1000 participants, regardless of nationalities, ages, and races to join us. All teachers, students, and companies are welcomed as well.
  - it is best for entire family, department, class, and organization to join us. For instance,
    1. For a family with 3 generations, each can write a Chinese word (one word like family or spring).
    2. For married couples, one can write the 2 Chinese words for "harmony" and the other can write the 2 Chinese words for "prosperity". Or each can write 2 Chinese words of the Chinese idiom for "May everything is smooth flowing".
    3. Physics Society of Chung Cheng High School can find 4 persons to write one piece with Chinese 4-worded idioms individually (like "love others like yourself", "be persevere".)
    4. For a group of 3 seniors, one can write the Chinese word for "blessings", the other can write the Chinese word for "wealth" and the last can write the Chinese word for "longevity".
    5. As next year is the year for Jade Hare, you can write the idioms related to this prosperous year, like "Bold Hare brings bravery, quality of moral and mental strength", "Hare brings a year of good harvests", "abundance of happiness in the year of hare" and "Hare year is an omen of courage".
- As the organizer, we will provide ink, red square rice paper, and ink stone. Please bring your own writing brush.
- The Chinese Calligraphy Society of Singapore will also hold a HuiChun demonstration at 2.30 p.m. on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2022 (Saturday) at the Singapore Calligraphy Centre. We will provide calligraphy brushes, ink, paper, and ink stone (i.e., the four treasures of calligraphy). Admission is free for all who wish to attend and learn how to HuiChun calligraphy.
- On the day of the convention, there will be a lucky draw conducted for the participants and the audiences. There will be 25 famous calligraphy pieces to be won.
- This HuiChun Convention is scheduled to be held before the Chinese New Year so that the participants can bring home the Spring couplets and paste them on their front doors or walls to add on the Chinese New Year festivity.
- **Pre-registered participants shall be given certificates of participation as commemorations.**
- This event is jointly sponsored by LianheZaobao, The Chinese Calligraphy Society of Singapore, National Arts Council, Lee Foundation, Singapore Arts Federation, and SPH Media Trust.

# 2023 第 40 届全国挥春大会

1. 全国挥春大会是本地挥春活动的鼻祖，自 1983 年至今已有 40 年的历史，比春到河畔迎新年还早四年举行。
2. 大会订于 2023 年 1 月 1 日（星期日）上午 9 时至下午 3 时，在新加坡书法中心 (48 Waterloo Street Singapore 187952 Tel: 6337 7753) 前后院及礼堂举行，以迎接癸卯年（玉兔年）。其中 9 时至 10 时 30 分为主场。
3. 新加坡书协主办的“第五届新加坡全国春联展”於上午 10 时开幕，至 2023 年 1 月 4 日（星期三）下午 4 时结束，欢迎公众阖府光临。
4. 挥春大会以每 15 分钟为一段，40 个挥毫柜台一齐进行，预料将有千人参加。参加者不分国籍、不分老少、不分种族。
5. 参加挥春大会，最好全家或整个部门、整个班级、整个学会前来，例如①祖孙三人，每人各写一个字：一/家/春②双人对，一个写“和气”，一个写“生财”；或者一个写“顺顺”一个写“利利”。③中正物理学会可找四个人，每人写一条，每条四个字：爱人爱己/不屈不挠。④三个乐龄人士，一个写福，一个写禄，一个写寿。⑤明年是兔年，你不妨自己写玉兔报喜/兔年大兴/玉兔报丰年/兔年喜气浓/兔兆丰年等等。
6. 主办当局将提供墨、砚、纸镇、垫布与斗方红纸，参加者只须自备毛笔。
7. 书协订于 2022 年 12 月 17 日(星期六) 下午 2 时 30 分于新加坡书法中心举办一个挥春示范会，提供笔墨纸砚等文房四宝，免费教导各界人士如何挥春。
8. 大会当天设有一个抽奖箱，特备 25 件名家书作，现场抽奖，用以鼓励参加者和所有参观者。
9. 挥春大会特在新年前举行，是为了让挥春者把春联带回家贴在门上、墙上，以增添新年气氛。
10. **预先于 12 月 19 日（星期一）前报名者，将获颁参加证书，以兹纪念。**
11. 此大会由《联合早报》、新加坡书法家协会联合主办•国家艺术理事会、李氏基金、新加坡艺术总会、新加坡新报业媒体信托联合赞助。
